MINUTES OF THE REGULAR BOARD MEETING

Board Members Present: Jessica Scott, Ashley Clausen, Denise Schoen, Ian Frasier, Brandi Duskie, Chandra Doane and Aaron Gasper

Administrators Present: Superintendent, Jesse Janssen and Principals: Jeremy Long, Gery Hake and Kayla Hamilton

Jessica Scott called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and informed all in attendance that the meeting would be recorded. She welcomed visitors.

Ashley Clausen moved and Chandra Doane seconded the motion to approve the Agenda as amended.

Motion carried by a show of hands, 6-0.

Ian Frasier joined the meeting at 6:01 p.m.

Denise Schoen moved and Aaron Gasper seconded the motion to approve the Consent Agenda as presented. Motion Carried 7-0 by a show of hands.

Chandra Doane reported that the Smoky Hill ESC Executive Cabinet discussed personnel and a Covid-19 leave policy.

The principals were asked if they had anything to add to their principal reports. Mr. Jeremy Long congratulated the boys' and girls' basketball teams as well as the seniors for a great season.

Superintendent, Mr. Jesse Janssen informed the board that the Parents as Teachers contract was up for renewal and that there was no change in the cost to the district. Mr. Janssen then asked the board to review the current LOB percentage rate which is 31% and to decide whether to increase it for the coming school year. Next, he reminded the board of the March 24th Negotiation meeting date and the March 8<sup>th</sup> KESA Outside Visitation Team meeting date.

Other items discussed were the purchase of another route bus, moving graduation to Sunday, May 8 to accommodate State Forensics Qualifiers, new business lab computers and the proposed LED signage. Mr. Janssen added that the CDC guidelines on masking has changed to where masks are no longer required on public transportation including school buses.

Discussion was had on consideration of a cooperative with Osborne to allow for wrestling in the future. Mr. Ashley Clausen mentioned that there may also be interest in a cooperative baseball team as well.

Denise Schoen moved and Ian Frasier seconded the motion to approve the Parents as Teachers Contract for \$12,139 as presented. Motion carried, 7-0 by a show of hands.

Brandi Duskie moved and Aaron Gasper seconded the motion to grant the superintendent spending authority for up to \$70,000 for the purchase of a bus. Motion carried, 7-0 by a show of hands.

Ashley Clausen moved and Chandra Doane seconded the motion to grant the superintendent spending authority for up to \$42,000 for the purchase of business lab computers. Motion carried, 7-0 by a show of hands.

Chandra Doane moved and Aaron Gasper seconded the motion to move the graduation to May 8, 2022 at 1:00 p.m. as presented. Motion carried, 7-0 by a show of hands.

Jessica Scott moved the school board recess into executive session to discuss non-elected personnel; pursuant to non-elected personnel exception under KOMA with the board and superintendent present, with the option to call in Mr.

Long, and the open meeting will resume in the board room at 6:40 p.m. The motion was seconded by Brandi Duskie. Motion carried 7-0 by a show of hands.

Mr. Long was invited into the executive session at 6:36 p.m.

The board returned to open session at 6:40 p.m.

Jessica Scott moved the school board recess into executive session to discuss non-elected personnel; pursuant to non-elected personnel exception under KOMA with the board, the superintendent and Mr. Long present, and the open meeting will resume in the board room at 6:46 p.m. The motion was seconded by Denise Schoen. Motion carried 7-0 by a show of hands.

The board returned to open session at 6:46 p.m.

Brandi Duskie moved the school board recess into executive session to discuss negotiations, pursuant to the exception under KOMA with the board and superintendent present, and the open meeting will resume in the board room at 6:58 p.m. Denise Schoen seconded the motion. Motion Carried, 7-0 by a show of hands.

The board returned to open session at 6:58 p.m.

Jessica Scott moved the school board recess into executive session to discuss negotiations, pursuant to the exception under KOMA with the board and superintendent present, and the open meeting will resume in the board room at 7:10 p.m. Brandi Duskie seconded the motion. Motion Carried, 7-0 by a show of hands.

The board returned to open session at 7:10 p.m.

Denise Schoen moved and Ashley Clausen seconded the motion to accept the resignations of: Rollin Roth as Special Education Route driver and Leo Mick as Special Education Monitor effective the end of the 2021-2022 school year and Cassi Walsh, FACS Teacher Assistant and FCCLA Sponsor at the end of the 2022-2023 school year. Motion carried 7-0 by a show of hands.

Chandra Doane moved to approve a new position: Student Success Coordinator as presented. Aaron Gasper seconded the motion. Motion carried 7-0 by a show of hands.

Ashley Clausen moved to increase the LOB percentage to 32 percent for the 2022-2023 school year. Motion failed by the lack of a second.

There was discussion on the LOB percentage rate and it was agreed upon by board members to keep the percentage at 31% for the 2022-2023 school year.


Brandi Duskie moved and Aaron Gasper seconded the motion to approve the LOB percentage remain at 31% for the 2022-2023 school year. Motion carried 7-0 by a show of hands.

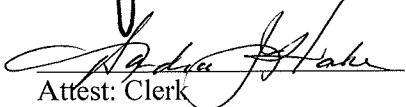

Motion Carried, 4-0.

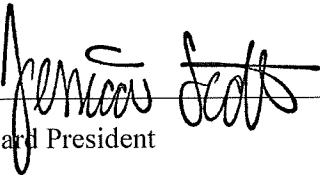
Chandra Doane moved and Ashley Clausen seconded the motion to approve transfers as presented.

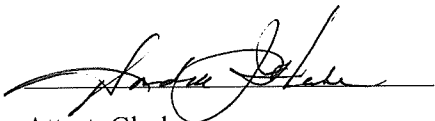
Transfers: \$80,000 from Supplemental General to Special Education
